This contract is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, _____ by and between the City of Sullivan, Illinois, hereinafter referred to as City, and _____ hereinafter referred to as Customer.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, City owns and operates an electrical transmission and distribution system known as the Sullivan Electric Department, serving the businesses and residences of the City of Sullivan and certain environs, and

WHEREAS, Customer proposes to install a renewable generator of either less than 10 kW or meeting the Sullivan Electric Department review, and is described as _____, and

WHEREAS, City is willing to net meter said interconnected renewable generator, all in accordance with the terms and provisions hereinafter set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and mutual undertakings hereinafter set forth, it is agreed by and between the City and Customer as follows.

1. Customer understands that any costs the City of Sullivan incurs associated with the net metering program, including but not limited to changes in metering, other physical facilities or billing-related costs, shall be borne by the participants in the net metering program provided however that such costs shall be capped at \$1,000 to each qualifying customer interconnecting facilities of 10 kW or less. For those

facilities greater than 10 kW that are deemed to qualify under the City's net metering ordinance, all costs associated with the program shall be borne by the participant.

2. The Customer's generating facility must also abide by the Sullivan Electric Department's Rules and Specifications.

3. It is also understood that Customer generated energy in excess of the energy required by the Customer's load during a billing period shall be carried forward to the next billing period. Upon closing of an account Customer's shall surrender to the City of Sullivan any excess energy. Under no circumstances will there be payments, or credit transfers, for excess energy.

4. The Customer understands that the City of Sullivan is to be held harmless for any liabilities associated with the operation of the Customer's generating facilities.

5. Customer understands the terms and conditions of net metering are governed by the City, and are subject to change. The initial term of this agreement shall be one year, and shall remain in effect until canceled by the City or the Customer. There is no guarantee of net metering in perpetuity.
